Jim Psaras is a staff member and lecturer at the famed Five-Star Basketball Camps. In addition, he has lectured at Providence College, University of Rhode Island, and Bryant University Basketball Camps. Psaras' twenty years experience at the camps provides him with a broad spectrum of instructional skills and fundamentals.

Psaras, a point guard at Rogers in 1982, began his coaching career in 1985-1986 at Thompson Middle School. He became the Rogers freshman coach in 1986-1987. He then moved to the junior varsity coach for the 1987-1988 season, while working on his degree in physical education at the University of Rhode Island. Two months before he graduated from URI in 1990, Psaras led Rogers to its first state title since 1963; then, made it two in a row in 1991. His coaching abilities led him to another state title in 1993.
